The XML price list displays the regular prices and promotional prices for domains, trustees, premium price classes<sup>1)</sup> and SSL certificates.

## Activation of the XML Price List in AutoDNS

You can activate the XML price list via your AutoDNS account.

- Menü group **User Administration**
- Menu entry **User Configuration**
- Click **User Profile** in the main area
- Tab **API Settings**
- Section **XML Price List**

### Deleting the Activation

### Query

You can call up the price list in XML format with a simple HTTP GET request to the URL [https://api.autodns.com/v1/document/price\\_list.xml](https://api.autodns.com/v1/document/price_list.xml). The price list is updated once a day at 22:00 Europe/Berlin.



Please note that the price list is available after it has been initially generated for the first time

### Authentication

Authentication is implemented via BasicAuth. You will receive your user name and password for the price list at the time of activation in the AutoDNS interface.

### HTTP Status Codes

## MIME Type

The content type must be specified as `application/json`, `*/*`.

If successful, the corresponding MIME type of the document is returned, in this case `application/xml`.

In case of an error, the answer will be returned as `application/json`.

## The Objects

### Object PriceList

The object *priceList* represents the complete price list.

The *article* object represents the article group that is listed in the price list.

### Object Price

The *price* object represents the price of the articles.

1) Premium domains contain high-value keywords and are therefore considered as very popular. For this reason, the respective registry sets significantly higher prices for these domains, which are divided into price categories. The respective registry also decides which domains get the status of premium domains.

2) Grandfather domains are new gTLD domains that were registered before a price increase. The old price applies for renewals.
